

SUMMARY OF 2014 PROXY VOTING RESULTS

ExxonMobil thanks the many shareholders who returned their proxies. More than 3.5 billion, or about 83 percent, of the outstanding shares were represented at this year's meeting.

On average, more than 97 percent of the votes were cast for the 12 persons nominated by the Board to serve as directors: Michael J. Boskin, Peter Brabeck-Letmathe, Ursula M. Burns, Larry R. Faulkner, Jay S. Fishman, Henrietta H. Fore, Kenneth C. Frazier, William W. George, Samuel J. Palmisano, Steven S Reinemund, Rex W. Tillerson, and William C. Weldon.

The Ratification of Independent Auditors, Advisory Vote to Approve Executive Compensation, and the five shareholder proposals received votes as detailed in the table below. The Board's position on each shareholder proposal is contained in the proxy statement.
