

SUMMARY OF 2020 PRELIMINARY PROXY VOTING RESULTS

ExxonMobil thanks the many shareholders who returned their proxies. Nearly 3.5 billion, or over 82 percent, of the outstanding shares were represented at this year's meeting.

On average, over 93 percent of the votes were cast for the 10 persons nominated by the Board to serve as directors: Susan K. Avery, Angela F. Braly, Ursula M. Burns, Kenneth C. Frazier, Joseph L. Hooley, Steven A. Kandarian, Douglas R. Oberhelman, Samuel J. Palmisano, William C. Weldon, and Darren W. Woods.

The Ratification of Independent Auditors, Advisory Vote to Approve Executive Compensation, and the six shareholder proposals received votes as detailed in the table below. The Board's position on each shareholder proposal is contained in the proxy statement, which can be found at www.exxonmobil.com/proxymaterials.
