MOZAMBIQUE ROVUMA VENTURE S.p.A (MRV) PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

PROVISION OF FIT-OUT WORKS AND NECESSARY INSTALLATIONS FOR OFFICES LOCATED IN MAPUTO

Mozambique Rovuma Venture S.p.A (MRV), Operator of the Area 4 Block in the Rovuma Basin in the Republic of Mozambique invites interested companies (hereinafter referred to as "Candidates") duly qualified to submit their expression of interest ("Expression of Interest") for the supply and execution of renovation and fit-out works for **ExxonMobil Mozambique's** offices in Maputo.

The execution of this project is expected to commence in November 2026

This initiative aims to select a General Contractor with proven technical and financial capacity to execute the project within the required quality, schedule, and safety parameters.

SCOPE OF WORK

The project consists of fit-out works and necessary installations for the interior renovation of four (4) office floors in the **JN3412 Block 2** building, located on Avenida Julius Nyerere, in Maputo. The total intervention area in the offices is approximately **3,000 m²**.

The intervention includes, but is not limited to, the following works:

- **Civil Construction Works:** Execution of flooring, walls, partitions, ceilings, painting, and alterations to the water and sewage network where necessary.
- **Electrical Installations:** Installation of conventional power reticulation and backup power system (UPS/Generator);
- **Data Installations:** Installation of structured data network (cabling and racks) and installation of active equipment;
- **Security and Surveillance:** Supply and installation of access control, CCTV, and intrusion systems;
- **Fire Safety:** Installation and/or adaptation of the fire detection and firefighting network (SADI and extinguishing means);
- **Carpentry and Furniture:** Manufacture and assembly of carpentry/joinery, built-in cabinets, and supply of special furniture;
- **Decoration:** Installation of decorative elements, signage, and special finishes;



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- **Other works:** Final cleaning, site management, and related works necessary for the "turnkey" delivery of the project.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

To be considered, Candidates must submit the following documentation:

1. Experience and Technical Capacity:

- Provide up to three recent examples, within the last 5 years of your company's experience in corporate office fit-out projects or high-standard interior finishes.
- Evidence of technical capabilities (Engineering, project management, procurement, etc.) and capacity to execute projects of this size, including CVs of key professionals such as Project Manager, Site Supervisor, and Health and Safety Officer.

2. Legal Qualification and Local Content:

- Updated Commercial Registration Certificate of the company;
- Publication in the Official Gazette (*Boletim da República* - BR) of the company's articles of association, including any subsequent amendments;
- Licenses, permits, and authorizations relevant to the provision of the civil construction services described in the scope of work;

- Updated Tax Clearance Certificate (*Certidão Negativa de Débitos*), issued within the last 3 months;
- Proof of registration of the Ultimate Beneficial Owners (UBOs) of the company in compliance with Anti-Money Laundering and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT) legislation.
- Class 7 Civil Constructions Alvara

3. Financial Information:

- Audited Annual Financial Reports for the last 3 years;
- Demonstration of the capacity to mobilize funds to support a project of this nature.

4. Governance:

- Presentation of the company's Governance, Social, and Environmental Policy (ESG Policy).

Candidates may include other relevant documents they consider important for the evaluation.

Additionally, Candidates are requested to register and submit the documents listed above. Submissions must be uploaded via the Supplier Management Portal (<https://prod-moz.daismp.com/>) by the deadline indicated below.

After submitting the documents on the portal, Candidates must send an e-mail confirming the submission to the following address:

The e-mail must include the **Cover Letter**, declaration of interest, contact details, and the following **mandatory supporting attachments**:

- **Company Org Chart and Institutional Profile:** Overview highlighting the size of the company (turnover, number of employees, etc.);
- **Declaration on Corporate Structure:** Information on joint venture, consortium, or other planned structure, with data for each participating company, if applicable;
- **Declaration on Local Content:** Strategy for the use of local suppliers and labour;

- **Evidence of General Contractor:** Proof that the company acts as a General Contractor with proven experience in the area;
- **Compliance (FCPA/UKBA):** Evidence that the company possesses compliance systems with the *Foreign Corrupt Practices Act* (FCPA) and the *UK Bribery Act*.

This EOI is being issued with the objective of identifying Mozambican companies capable of delivering the required scope efficiently and sustainably, and within the required timeframe and level of quality. Thus, a preference will be given to respondents that can demonstrate an established local presence and a delivery model that meaningfully supports local workforce participation and engagement of local suppliers.

Respondents are requested to outline how local content considerations have been incorporated into their proposed approach and should demonstrate their capacity and intent to support local content's outcomes relevant to the scope of work. This includes opportunities for local employment, engagement of local businesses, and contribution to local economic development.

Submissions that rely primarily on international or offshore resources, or that do not demonstrate a substantive and ongoing local operating capability, may be assessed as less competitive.



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Only Candidates who meet the qualification process requirements and demonstrate relevant experience will be invited to participate in a potential tender.

This request should not be considered an invitation to tender and does not represent or constitute any promise, offer, obligation, or commitment of any kind on the part of MRV to enter into any agreement or contract with the Candidates, nor does it confer upon the Candidates the right to claim any compensation from MRV.

Subsequently, Candidates will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement before receiving any additional information from MRV.

The deadline for submission of the Expression of Interest is set for: **1 July 2026 at 15:00 (Maputo time).**



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
