ExxonMobil announces leadership change at Baton Rouge Polyolefins Plant

Baton Rouge, LA — ExxonMobil has named Jonathan Morgan as the new Baton Rouge Polyolefins Plant Manager, effective June 1, 2022. Morgan will replace Stephen Hamilton, who has elected to retire after 37 years of service.

Hamilton led the Polyolefins Plant for four years and was an active community leader. During his tenure at the Polyolefins Plant, he was instrumental in getting the Polypropylene Project along with significant improvements in people development, business team restructuring and major infrastructure improvements. Steve leaves a legacy behind of community service and a strong safety culture mindset. Hamilton served as the employee resource group sponsor for the Baton Rouge chapter of PRIDE and the Louisiana Chemical Industry Association and Baker Chamber of Commerce boards during his time here.

A native of Mississippi, Morgan returns to Baton Rouge 17 years after beginning his career at the site in 2005. After working several engineering related assignments he was promoted to the Polyethylene Section Supervisor. In 2013, Jonathan transferred to company headquarters in Spring, Texas as the Global Synthetics and Oxy Fluids Supply Planner. In 2015, he became the Global Olefins Commercial Planner and then became the Americas Manufacturing Planning Manager in 2017. Most recently Jonathan was in Mont Belvieu as the Plastics Plant Process Manager before moving back to Baton Rouge to become the Polyolefins Plant Manager.

Morgan has a BS in Chemical Engineering from Mississippi State University and is married to Susan. They are the parents of one son and one daughter.
