Land Area

- 370 acres

Workforce

- Approximately 420 employees with an average of 950 contract personnel.

Production

- Manufactures ~10 billion pounds of petrochemical products each year which are shipped via pipeline.
- Houses cogeneration facilities that produce ~ 70% of the power and steam required to operate the Baytown Complex.

Products & Their End Uses

- Ethylene - Recycling bags, plastic packaging/wrap, waterproof layer on diapers
- Propylene - Carpeting, upholstery, automotive plastic components, child car safety seats
- Butadiene - Tires, fabrics, engineered plastics, rubber

Taxes

- Approximately \$39M (property, city, county, school and college) in 2025.

Community Involvement

- Annually, Baytown area employees, retirees and their families contribute thousands of hours volunteering. In recognition of these efforts, ExxonMobil contributed thousands of dollars in volunteer grants in 2025 to non-profit organizations where they volunteered.
- Area charitable contributions totaled more than \$1.7M in 2025.
- In addition, ExxonMobil employees and retirees raised over \$1M for the 2025 United Way of Greater Baytown Area and Chambers County Campaign.

- Committed to running safe and environmentally responsible operations.
