LAND AREA: 1,050 acres

WORKFORCE: 1,068 employees and 1,806 contractors*

PRODUCTION: 480k barrels per day of total input capacity, including 384k barrels per day of crude oil, making it the eighth-largest refinery in the U.S.

PRODUCTS: Premium and regular gasoline, low sulfur diesel fuel, jet fuel, liquid petroleum gases, fuel oil blendstock, petroleum coke, petroleum feedstocks.

TAXES: \$32.8 million in local taxes paid annually.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: Employees and retirees volunteered more than 3,000 hours in 2022 and contributed \$52,500 in VIP matching grants.

INVESTMENT:

- Beaumont Refinery Expansion – The Beaumont Refinery Expansion is the addition of a third crude unit and distillate hydrotreating at the refinery complex to increase production of diesel fuel. The addition will increase crude capacity by more than 65 percent, or 250,000 barrels per day.
