Laura Eiklor named new Plastics Plant manager

ExxonMobil has named Laura Eiklor as the new Plastics Plant and Resin Finishing Plant manager, effective June 1, 2023.

Eiklor replaces Kristin Thomas-Martin, who now serves as regional polyethylene sales manager within Product Solutions in Spring, TX. The Plastics Plant employs about 440 employees and contractors and manufactures low-density polyethylene, Vistamaxx® and Exact® specialty elastomers, and Escorez® resins with end uses such as plastic films, molding, wire and cable applications and more.

Eiklor, a chemical engineering graduate from Pennsylvania State University, has been with the company for 15 years. She began her career as a contact engineer at the Baton Rouge Chemical Plant. In 2010, she began a planning role at Chemical Headquarters until 2012 when she moved to the Beaumont Chemical Plant as technical supervisor and later became engineering supervisor at the Beaumont Polyethylene Plant. From 2017 to 2021, Eiklor worked in product management and planning at headquarters until moving back to Baton Rouge as polymers process department head at the Chemical Plant where she worked until this new role.

In addition to her role as Plastics Plant manager, Eiklor will serve on the Baker Chamber of Commerce board of directors and will step into the management sponsor role for WIN.

She lives in East Baton Rouge with her husband, Dan, and two children. Outside of work, Eiklor can be found enjoying a local park or playground or listening to live music.
