Facility

- The Baytown Technology & Engineering Complex (BTEC) is one of ExxonMobil's largest global technology centers, located within the greater ExxonMobil Baytown Complex.
- BTEC encompasses two major facilities with more than 740,000 square feet of space for offices, laboratories and pilot plant operations.

Employees

- Approximately 612 employees and 170 contract, including scientists, engineers, staff support, technicians and other professionals, about 151 of whom are PhDs.

- Exxon Mobil Corporation (100%)

Services

- BTEC is home to employees who provide technical support to all of ExxonMobil's chemical product lines such as Olefins; Aromatics; Intermediates such as hydrocarbon and oxygenated fluids; Polymers such as polyethylene, polypropylene, elastomers, butyl rubber and adhesion products; and Synthetic lubricants such as Mobil 1© products.
- Services span research and development, product and process scale-up, and technology support for ExxonMobil's customers.
- BTEC also houses the technical capabilities needed to support the development of sustainable solutions, from advanced recycling of plastic waste to novel technologies for ExxonMobil's Low Carbon Solutions business.

Taxes Paid

- Annual taxes (property, city, county, school and college) were \$3.1 million in 2021.

Economic Impact

- Annual salaries and wages are approximately \$96 million

Community Impact

- Annually, Baytown area employees, retirees and their families contribute thousands of hours volunteering at more than 200 organizations. In recognition of these efforts, ExxonMobil contributed thousands of dollars in volunteer grants to non-profit organizations where they volunteered.
- Area charitable contributions totaled more than \$1.1 million in 2022.
- In addition, ExxonMobil, employees and retirees raised \$1.2 million for the 2022 United Way of Greater Baytown Area and Chambers County Campaign.
